TREE REMOVAL PERMIT

Mountainside Ordinance Article 13, Section 1302, defines Tree as: Any living woody perennial plant having a diameter greater than twelve (12) inches at a point four and one-half (4.5) feet above ground level.

Article 13, Section 1304 states: A person desiring to remove or destroy more than five (5) trees within a twelve (12) month period shall apply to the Enforcement Officer for a permit to remove such trees.

This application must be accompanied by a sketch containing the following information:

1. A description of the premises upon which the tree removal is to take place, such as a photocopy of current survey.
2. The size of the lot.
3. The location where the removal of trees is to take place.
4. The identity of and number of trees to be removed, depicting those >12" and those < 12" in diameter.
5. The purpose of the removal of the trees.
6. Proposals, if any, for replacing any destroyed or removed trees.
7. The location of all streams on the lot or adjacent premises.
8. Attach sketch/survey to application.

APPEAL PROCESS

You have the right to appeal the Enforcement Officer's decision denying the above permit. Within ten (10) days of said decision, the applicant may appeal in writing to the Mountainside Planning Board. The Planning Board shall decide the appeal within sixty (60) days of the receipt of the appeal. The failure of the Planning Board to decide the appeal within the sixty (60) days shall constitute reversal of the decision by the Enforcement Office.
